

Rev. Dominique M. Doyon, O.P.

AUBURN — Rev. Dominique M. Doyon, O.P., 89, of 27 Bartlett St., Lewiston, died Wednesday morning at Clover Hospice following a long illness.

He was born in Beauceville, Quebec, July 2, 1902, the son of Joseph and Josephine (Poulin) Doyon. He was the last survivor of 17 children. After his studies in St. Victor in Beauce and Que-



bec he joined the Dominican Fathers in St. Hyacinthe for his noviciate, followed by theological studies in Ottawa. After a brief ministry in Quebec, he was assigned to Japan from 1935 to 1945. He had lived four years in a Japanese concentration camp near Tokyo during WWII.

After the war he was assigned to Lewiston in 1953. He was chaplain at St. Mary's Hospital and the formerly Healy Asylum.

Survivors include many nieces and nephews.
