WNY Franciscans Will Be Ordained In Monastery Rites

WASHINGTON, March 1 — Two Franciscans from Western New York will be ordained tomorrow by Archbishop Egidio Vagnozzi, Apostolic Delegate to the United States, in the Franciscan Monastery, Washington, D. C. They are:

The Rev. Mr. Bernard Jerom Splawski, OFM, son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph J. Splawski, 1219 E. State St., Olean, N. Y., and the Rev. Mr. Anthony Augustine Struzynski, OFM, son of Mr and Mrs. Albert Struzynski, 204 S. Ermine St., Dunkirk, N. Y.

After studying under the Franciscan Fathers at St. Bonaventure University, both men entered the Franciscan Order. After two years of biological studies at St. Bonaventure, Father Bernard entered St. Joseph's Seraphic Seminary, Callicoon, N. Y.

Father Anthony entered St. Joseph's after having obtained a Bachelor of Business Administration degree from St. Bonaventure.

Father Bernard will celebrate his First Solemn Mass at 10 o'clock Sunday morning, March 10, in the Church of the Transfiguration, Olean.

The reception and First Blessing will be from 1 PM until 4:30 PM in Archbishop Walsh High School. Dinner will follow the reception in the Castle Restaurant.

Father Anthony will celebrate his First Solemn High Mass at 11:30 o'clock Sunday, March 10, in St. Hyacinth's Church, Lake Shore Dr., E. Dunkirk, N. Y.

Breakfast will follow the Mass in the parish lyceum. A reception and First Blessing, also in the parish lyceum, will be from 4 until 7 o'clock.

After a short vacation at home, the new priests will return to Washington to complete their theological studies. Next fall they will begin their pastoral theological studies at St. Anthony's Shrine, Boston.
