

REV. EMILE W. SAVARY

UNDERHILL — The Rev. Emile W. Savary, 49, pastor of St. Thomas's Church here, died Wednesday of a heart attack.

He was stricken Monday evening while attending a retreat-conference at Winooski, and died Wednesday afternoon at Fanny Allen Hospital.

A native of Central Falls, R.I., he was a veteran of World War II service with the 113th Infantry, and was ordained in Providence, R. I., in 1954.

In Vermont, he had served as assistant pastor at Catholic parishes in Orleans, Newport, Burlington, Richford and South Burlington, as chaplain of St. Joseph's Home for the Aged in Newport and at St. Joseph's Child Center in Burlington.

He is survived by a brother and six sisters.

A Solemn High Mass of Requiem will be celebrated Friday at 9 a. m. at St. Thomas's Church. At 11 a. m. Friday the Most Rev. Robert F. Joyce, bishop of the Burlington diocese, will concelebrate a Requiem Mass at the chapel of St. Michael's College, Winooski.

Burial will be in Central Falls.
