

Father Stauber leaves Assumption faculty

In an announcement to students at Assumption High School, the Rev. J. Thomas Finucan, principal, said that the Rev. James Stauber, an instructor at the school the past year and a half, has left Wisconsin Rapids because of illness and will be hospitalized near St. Louis for several weeks.

Father Stauber, who has been serving as an assistant pastor at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Nekoosa in addition to his teaching duties, is expected to be reassigned following hospitalization, according to the announcement.

The Rev. Fr. Finucan said it has not been determined who will fill the faculty vacancy at Assumption.
