

Rev. G. A. Sharland services tomorrow

Services for the Rev. Gerald A. Sharland, 55, pastor of St. Patrick's Church, Rouses Point, who died Sunday morning, will be at 11 a.m. tomorrow in St. Patrick's Church, the Most Rev. Stanislaus Brznan, bishop of the Diocese of Ogdensburg, officiating. Burial will be in the parish cemetery.

Surviving besides his mother are five brothers and three sisters and several nieces and nephews. Arrangements are by the Clark Funeral Home, Rouses Point.

Father Sharland was found dead in bed shortly before the 7 a.m. Mass Sunday by his parish assistant, the Rev. Raoul Poirier. He had been suffering from a heart ail-

ment since last summer.

Born in Malone Feb. 23, 1918, he was a son of Mrs. Elzire Morrisette Sharland and the late Alex Sharland. He was ordained March 17, 1945, in old St. Mary's Cathedral in Ogdensburg and came to Notre Dame Church in Malone for his first assignment. In 1950 he was assigned to St. Patrick's at Rouses Point as an assistant and later was appointed pastor of St. Henry's Church in Long Lake. In 1959 he was returned St. Patrick's pastor, succeeding the Rev. Msgr. Robert Arquiett.
