


Diocese Will Acquire New Priest on June 12 At Rites in Maryland

**First Solemn Mass Is Scheduled for June 15
In Pikesville, Md.; Ordinand
Taught at Hilger, Malta**

The Rev. Joseph S. Heretick will be raised to the sacred priesthood on June 12 in the Cathedral of the Basilica of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Baltimore, Md., by the Most Rev. John M. McNamara, D.D. Father Heretick will offer his first Solemn Mass on Sunday, June 15, at 10:30 o'clock in St. Charles' church, Pikesville, Md. The Rev. Thad Skrzyski, pastor, will act as assistant priest. The Rev. Maurice King of the Church of the Ascension, Bowie, Md., will deliver the sermon for the occasion. Fathers John Hart and Thomas Fannon, both of Baltimore,

will serve as deacon and subdeacon, respectively.

Father Heretick is the son of Mr. and Mrs. William Heretick, who have their home in Baltimore.

He was born Oct. 28, 1920, in North Braddock, Pa., and attended the grade school in that town. He moved to Hopewell, Va., and completed his grade school studies in the parochial school attached to St. James' church. His high school studies were completed at St. Joseph's of Petersburg, Va. After high school, Father Heretick entered the Seminary of St. Charles, Catonsville, Md. After spending a year there, he completed his college training in the College of Mt. St. Mary's, Emmitsburg, Md.

After signing with the Diocese of Great Falls, Mont., he was sent to the major seminary of Mt. Angel, St. Benedict, Ore., to pursue his theological course. During the summer months of vacation, Father Heretick was engaged in the teaching of catechetical work throughout the diocese at Hilger and its missions, and also at Malta and missions.
