

Father Kohlman

Rosary for the Rev. Leonard A. Kohlman, S.J., 51, pastor of St. Michael's Mission, Inchelium, will be at 7:30 tomorrow evening at the mission. Concelebrated Funeral Mass with the bishop of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Spokane, the Most Rev. Bernard J. Topel, officiating, will be at 10 Saturday at St. Michael's Mission.

A memorial Mass will be at 3:30 Saturday at the Jesuit House on the Gonzaga University campus. Graveside services will be held here at Mount St. Michael's Cemetery.

Father Kohlman was killed, apparently on Sunday, when his truck went over a 400-foot embankment. He was found dead in his truck Tuesday morning.

The priest had celebrated the 9 a.m. Mass Sunday at St. Michael's Mission and was en route to Twin Lakes, Wash., where he was to offer Mass.

He was born in Colorado in 1921 and, with his family, moved to Yakima as a child. He entered the Society of Jesus in 1939 at Sheridan, Ore., after graduating from Marquette Jesuit High School, Yakima. He was ordained June 20, 1953.

Father Kohlman had been at Inchelium since 1966. His previous pastoral assignments included St. Paul's Mission, Hays, Mont., 1955 to 1962, and St. Mary's Mission, Omak, 1962 to 1966.

Surviving are his mother, Mrs. Theresa Kohlman, Yakima; a sister, Mrs. Walter H. (Rosemary) Ware, Kennewick, and a brother, Leo, Walden, Colo.
